

### **This week's family devotion.**

(1) In our new study of the book of Romans we have learned that the Apostle Paul is the human author of the book. (See 2 Timothy 3:16-17) As a family turn to Acts Chapter 8 and read verses 1-3 to get a glimpse into Saul's life before he was saved, note that Saul's name was later changed to Paul. (See Acts 13:9)

(2) Turn to Acts chapter nine and read verses one through nineteen about the conversion of Saul.

(3) Look up the definition of an apostle. A good place to start is on the website, [www.gotquestions.org](http://www.gotquestions.org). With all research of biblical matters be sure that you are using reliable sources and that all information begins with the premise that Scripture is our highest source of authority. Prayer is another essential part of studying and understanding Scripture, the Holy Spirit is our teacher, read I Corinthians 2:10-16. When researching it is always a good idea to use several reliable resources.
