Beloved,

Our passage on Sunday was Romans 5:12-21. We by no means covered this entire periscope during our worship service. The main focus was on verses 12-14. In these three verses Adam is used as a *type* as one discovers in verse fourteen. In this passage Adam is the illustration and Christ Jesus is the subject.

To further develop a biblical theology on sin entering the human race take time to go over the following information with your family.

Regarding the creation of man read Genesis chapter one. Pay special attention to verse twenty-six, discuss with your family what it means to be created in God's image.

Next, read Genesis chapter five, pay special attention to verse three. Discuss with your family what the difference is between Genesis 1:26 and Genesis 5:3.

Questions to ponder, was Adam from the outset created to be immortal? Why was Adam held responsible for the fall when it was Eve who first partook of the forbidden fruit? Do we know what kind of fruit it was? For example, many people say it was an apple, does Scripture support this?
