Our current book study on Romans has been referring to father Abraham quite a bit. Take time to go to the book of Genesis and read the account found in Genesis regarding the life of Abraham. A good place to begin is in Genesis 11:24.

For this week read Genesis 11:24-14:24. This passage will tell of: the birth of Abram, the Lord's call on Abram's life, his trip to Egypt, the separation of Lot and Abram, and an encounter with Melchizedek.

Abraham is a very important person in the Bible. Not only is there much written about him in the Old Testament, but he is also very prevalent in the New Testament. His name is mentioned in the New Testament almost fifty times!
