Family Devotion #22
For the Week of February 11, 2018

Beloved,

On Sunday February 11th our sermon text was from Romans 6:1-14, with special emphasis on verses 1-7. The process of sanctification is prevalent in this periscope, look over the diagram that comes with this week's Family Devotion and discuss with your family the meaning of each of the lines and give working definitions for the terms such as sanctification and justification. Also, look over the text to clearly understand how this is being presented in the Word.

Talk about what it means to be baptized with Jesus in His death, burial, and resurrection. Talk about the Christian's *identity* in Jesus.

During the Sunday School hour our young people discussed our mission statement. Go over the mission statement of our church and work toward memorizing it and be sure to explain what each word in it means, such as worship, glorify, evangelize, etc.

We also talked about giving to the Lord. Now is a good time to teach the young people of our church to give as the Lord has prospered them and to understand what the difference is between giving as you have prospered and giving an offering. Several of the class members receive an allowance. Now is the time to teach them obedience in giving to the work of the Lord. Also, we discussed receiving money on their birthday. Should they give a portion of this money to the Lord? If so, how much?
