PRINCIPLES AND PRACTICAL APPLICATION

- 1. Iesus died for our sins.
- 2. Jesus was literally dead and was buried.
- 3. Jesus was raised from the dead on the third day.
- 4. Jesus appeared to Peter and the 12.
- 5. Jesus appeared to 500+ brothers.
- 6. Jesus appeared to Paul.
- 7. All of these eyewitness accounts regarding the resurrection of Jesus are given upon the AUTHORITY of SCRIPTURE.

APPLICATION: It is not possible to be a Christian and not believe in the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead. It is not enough to believe about the gospel of Jesus Christ, you must believe in the gospel of Jesus Christ. Romans 10: 8-13 states, "8 But what does it say? "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart"—that is, the word of faith which we are preaching, 9 that if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved; 10 for with the heart a person believes, resulting in righteousness, and with the mouth he confesses, resulting in salvation. 11 For the Scripture says, "Whoever believes in Him will not be put to shame." 12 For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek; for the same Lord is Lord of all, abounding in riches for all who call on Him; 13 for "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."
