PRINCIPLES AND PRACTICAL APPLICATION

- 1. For the first time in Scripture, Deuteronomy 33:1, the title, "Man Of God", is given to Moses. Keep in mind that, "All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness; so that the man of God may be adequate, equipped for every good work." (II Timothy 3:16-17) So, this is God saying this.
- 2. In verses 2-5 Moses speaks of the coming of the Lord. This is called a "Theophany." A theophany is, "a manifestation of God in the Bible that is tangible to the human senses. In its most restrictive sense, it is a visible appearance of God in the Old Testament period, often, but not always, in human form." (This definition is from J. I. Packer, see his book, *Knowing God*, to learn more.)
- 3. Have you ever thought about it like this, the giving of the Law gave the people of Israel a constitution

APPLICATION:
