PRINCIPLES AND PRACTICAL APPLICATION

Remember the past! Israel is told to “remember” sixteen (16) times in the book of Deuteronomy.

The point of God judging Israel was not to annihilate her but to bring her to the point she understood that there is no god besides the Lord God. He alone has the power over death and life. Israel would not experience God’s compassion until they had relinquished all trust in their own efforts and false gods.

Some things we can know about God through this song:

God is our Rock, He is perfect. All of God’s ways are just. God is a God of faithfulness. God is a God without injustice. He is righteous and upright. In Christ, God is our Father. He made you. He established you. God set up the nations. God cares for & guides you. God is a jealous God. God gets angry with sin. God chastises disobedience by His children. Vengeance and retribution belong to God. The Lord vindicates His people. The Lord has compassion on His servants. God wounds and God heals. There is no god besides our God. God renders vengeance on His adversaries.

APPLICATION:

God loves His children. He guards them like the apple of His eye. This statement means that He is just as attentive to His children as He would be to something touching the pupil of His eye, so to speak. In these changing times in which we live we can trust Him to take care of us. He has not forgotten or overlooked us. Trust Him, think over the attributes listed above. Meditate on the character of God and who you are in Christ.
